

Homework Schedule KS1 (Year 1 and 2)

Homework will be given out weekly on a Thursday and is to be completed in the homework books provided. It will be due back on Tuesday of the following week. Children should spend no more than 30/60 minutes a week on homework at this stage.

- *Phonics* homework (phonics sounds of the week to practise)
- *Spelling* words (linked to Jolly phonics/high frequency words) – learn them and write sentences using them in the Homework Book
- *Grammar* – A page from the Jolly Phonics or Grammar book provided
- *Maths* – Collins Booklet – A page linked to the lessons of the previous week
- *Reading* – ORT book/other books every night plus **Reading Comprehension (Year 1 use StudyLadder and Year 2 use Collins Comprehension book)**
- *Science and Social Studies as required by the year group/teacher (specified on agenda)*
- *Study Ladder* activities to supplement

Please ensure that at this stage you spend quality time with your children discussing and talking about their day, their interests, etc. They should also have plenty of time to play and explore. This is just as important as 'academic' homework.
